Dear Friends, *Summer 2019*

Well, it's been quite a summer in Alaska! We just experienced the hottest June on record for Anchorage and much of Alaska. Record-breaking temperatures around the state and the driest month on record set us up for a very active wildfire season. To date this summer, we've had over 200 wildfires across the state – some of them quite large. We are thankful that no lives have been lost.

We just completed another season of youth camps in Western Alaska where we saw the wonderful hand of God touching lives. Many hearts and lives were changed, and each service was a special and unique time in the presence of God's Word and Spirit. **Enclosed are some pictures of highlights.**

In addition to the exciting spiritual harvest, **God also enabled us to build a workers' dorm** that will house a second cook (the other cook is housed in a room off the kitchen). The cabin has multiple rooms and will also house the camp speaker. Another bunk room will house construction workers while working on projects. The cabin will prove to be a great addition to the facilities at Camp Agaiutim Nune. We were also able to get our new water system up and running. This helped greatly in providing safe drinking and cooking water for the camp. Previously we had to haul it from Emmonak at great expense in gas for the boat.



We are so thankful for the many who help make these projects possible as well as the great workers who help with the campers and those who pray and send funds to help with the operation of the camp. **You are all sowing and reaping in God's fields and we ask Him to reward you accordingly!**

For the coming year (and beyond), the camp is in need of a another cook and we ask you to please be in prayer with us for the Lord to lay this on someone's heart. We will also be looking for a maintenance worker and help (personnel and funds) to replace the foundation under our outhouses. This project will require four to six men who are physically up to the work (digging and lifting).

Camp AN would not be possible without the donated finances and labor of friends all over the United States donating their time and paying their way to Alaska. **If you are part of those special people, we love and appreciate your sacrifice. There will be a multitude of people in Heaven because of your willingness to be a part of our ministry here.**

In other news, we recently discovered that the church in Anchorage (Crossroads Assembly) had foundation damage from the November 2018 earthquake. We did not discover this until the snow melted and are now waiting on engineering information regarding foundation block work and then we will do the internal sheetrock repairs. Please pray with us for God's direction and provision. We have come to know that God is able to provide for all the work He calls us to do and that we are "more than conquerors through him who loved us."
