Just before Camp AN 2022 started, we had a full complement of skilled kitchen help signed up—a REAL ANSWER TO PRAYER. They did a marvelous job. No complaints from the campers on the food for sure. They were a blessing to us all. **Praise God!**

Our church in Anchorage is still struggling to recover from the pandemic damage. Please pray with us as we reach into the surrounding community. We have had some move away and the couple that were assisting us have gone into US Missions, heading for Emmonak as missionaries. We felt a confirmation of God's calling them and we blessed them as they went. There is great need in the area and they will be a blessing to the camp as staff come and go through the village of Emmonak. Please pray as we seek the Lord's guidance to replace them.
